Did you know that a windstorm blew the town of Ward 500 feet downhill from its first location west of the present Peak to Peak Highway and it was rebuilt where the lumber landed? The town of Ward dates from the spring of 1860 when gold mines flourished and mills were in demand. Five hundred oxen were used to pull all the wagons across the plains and up Left Hand Canyon

loaded with machinery for a 40-stamp mill. Fast forward to August 10, 2013 and you can join us for a scenic drive up Hwy 119 through Nederland, and on to Ward, where we will spend some time at Brainard Lake. Afterwards we will stop for lunch in Ward, then go through Left Hand Canyon, on through Lyons and back to Boulder. And, you won't need oxen - you can make the trip in the comfort of your Benz. It's a sure bet the roads are better now, too!
